BETTER TRANSPORT & PARKING

Despite having two stations, Windsor is less well served by rail than any neighboring town. Over the last few decades, when the population has grown enormously, the train services have actually got dramatically worse. It is time Windsor did something about it.

The Windsor Link Railway will provide faster and more frequent trains to Waterloo and Paddington, saving 20% off journey times on average and reducing variability.

It provides better integration of train services with the retail core of the town and with bus and taxi services. It also creates an opportunity to restore the riverside area.

Integrated car, bus and rail transport with new single station by existing Central station

New through rail service via tunnel under Thames Avenue

20% journey time improvement to London and elsewhere
